Dear St. Robert Summer School Community,

Governor Newsom recently shared the strategic plan of reopening California with the extension of the stay-at-home order effective until May 22, 2020. As outlined in the strategic plan, we are currently in stage one – which outlines the continual opening of essential businesses. Stage two includes the opening of school and summer programs, which is expected to happen within the next month or two. We, at St. Robert Catholic School, are hopeful that our state will reach stage two by the anticipated opening date of our summer program. However, we have set out the following scenarios for opening the summer program:

Scenario 1: Open as planned on June 1 with social distancing with good hygiene and safety best practices in place.

Scenario 2: Delay the on-campus opening date until June 15 and extending the commencement date to accommodate a 7-week program. A distance learning option will be available.

Scenario 3: Delay the on-campus opening until June 28 and modify the program to commence on July 31. A distance learning option will be available June 1 through July 17, as planned.

Once we open for our on-campus summer program, we are prepared to lead with social distancing, maintaining smaller groups, putting in place best safety and cleaning practices and encouraging students to practice good handwashing hygiene. We will also continue to follow all employee guidelines set in place by the CDC.

We will continue to monitor the developments and notify you should anything change. Until then, we encourage you to follow our Facebook page, St. Robert School of Sacramento.

Greetings Families,

Don't let summer be a "brain-drain" for your children! Keep their minds active and expand their interests in a fun and friendly summer day camp atmosphere. Students entering Kindergarten through 8th Grades are invited to join us this summer for our Summer School Enrichment Camp-Summer Fun program:

- **Our Program** is a seven-week full day on campus or Distance Learning program for students entering Kindergarten through 8th grades:
 - The on campus morning session offers learning activities that build competencies in English Language Arts and Mathematics through creative lessons, educational projects, and computer labs. Small reading groups will be assembled, covering summer reading lists (from St. Robert School).
 - The on campus afternoon session keeps students learning in many enriching subjects including Art, Science, Computers, Cooking, Music, and Athletics. Weekly themes will be celebrated with field trips, special guests, and/or activities.
 - The Distance Learning option will have a curriculum specific to the student's needs, in addition to one or two virtual one on one sessions per week.
- **Extended Day** is available for students enrolled in our on campus summer program:
 - We offer an optional Extended Day Program which provides a safe, caring, and educational place for students before and after the summer program. Age appropriate, fun activities, such as arts and crafts, athletics, games, and educational projects keep students active and involved.
 - Extended Day hours are from 7:30-8:30 a.m. and from 3:30-6:00 p.m., daily throughout the seven-week program.
 - A light snack will be provided in the afternoon.
